At the end you will go home with a completed picture. Weiss's class begins Jan. 25 and runs for 6 weeks (no class Feb. 15).

### Pottery

Emily Sizemore, a young and talented potter from Nesting Doll Pottery, will be teaching: Beginners Wheel Throwing for Adults, Advanced Wheel Throwing and Hand Built Dinnerware starting in January. Sizemore will offer daytime and evening classes, each running 6 weeks. Beginners Wheel Throwing starts Jan. 18 and the Advanced Wheel Throwing begins on Jan. 19. The Dinnerware class starts Jan. 28.

### Fashion design

Tabitha Simmons, a graduate of the Savannah School of Art and Design, will teach an eight-week class beginning Jan. 19 from 6 to 8 p.m., Designing a Fashion Collection. Come learn the beginning steps of creating an
